1. Pioneers:

Pioneer classes are designed for new English learners. Apart from grammar lessons, all classes are taught in immersion English with a Japanese speaking teacher present. The pace and content of these classes are more advanced than the Explorers class. Students in the Daredevil classes will undertake end of term tests based on the content covered in classes as well as being assessed on class participation and completion of assigned tasks.
